

**MINUTES

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Marita Dinnini made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted of the Seniors Commission Meeting of September 7, 2017. The motion was seconded by Elaine Carrero and approved by all members of the Commission in attendance.

**CORRESPONDENCE, REPORTS AND OTHER MATTERS**

Chairperson Jeanette Remsen mentioned that she considered changing the date of the November Seniors Commission meeting due to an event that she will need to attend earlier in the day. After some discussion, she believes that she will be back in time for the start of the meeting. The November meeting will remain scheduled for Thursday, November 2, 2017.

The Commission discussed the idea of setting “pay by” dates on the trip fliers. After some discussion, the members agreed to not setting “pay by” dates and keeping “please pay A.S.A.P.” on the fliers

Jeanette noted that the January trip is booked for a lunch at Tomasello Winery and Resorts Casino for January 17, 2018. Jeanette is waiting to hear back from Safety Tours about booking the Wine Festival at The Waterfront at Silver Birches for April 12, 2018 and the Four Aces for September 12, 2018. Jeanette contacted the Atlantic Cape Community Culinary Arts about a sit-down dinner; they will be serving dinners February 8<sup>th</sup>-27<sup>th</sup>, March 2<sup>nd</sup>-28<sup>th</sup>, and April 3<sup>rd</sup>-20<sup>th</sup>. Marita Dinnini said that she spoke with Candlelight Theatre. They will send her a list of the shows; there are two matinees, one on Sundays and one on Wednesdays with doors opening at 1:00pm and show starting at 3:00pm, and was suggested for them to book early if they want to go. Jeanette asked the members for trip ideas for March. Marita said that where they’re going for the wine festival, Silver Birches, there seems to be a lot of events going on over there. Jeanette asked if they’d want to keep going to the same place. Jeanette mentioned the Culinary Arts and they’ll look at dates for February 8<sup>th</sup>-27<sup>th</sup>. A trip to Laugh Out Loud, Harrisburg and Dover Downs was mentioned. Jeanette asked for a date for the Pride of the Susquehanna boat trip and Alfred’s Victorian Restaurant; she will check on May 16<sup>th</sup> or 23<sup>rd</sup>. The show for the 2018 December trip to Sight and Sound Theatre is ‘Jesus’ and they would like to go to Shady Maple Smorgasbord to eat. Jeanette said that trip fliers will be put out for advertisement three months before the trip. The members will see about putting fliers at the Barclay Glen and Amberleigh club houses. The Commission needs to come up with a trip idea for March.
