Rich DiLucia spoke of the deregulation of electricity and gas in New Jersey and cautioned residents to be very careful when choosing an energy supplier because some companies are offering varying rates that provide lower rates in the beginning but within a few months those rates could increase anywhere from 25% to 40% more than Atlantic City Electric is charging. He explained the safest thing to do is to go with a company that guarantees their rate for one year. Cncl. DiLucia indicated he would provide a more detailed report on this at the next meeting.
