He also reported attending the Zoning Board Meeting on Tuesday, March 5th. The applicant at that meeting chose to table his application until the next meeting. Cncl. Caligiuri spoke of an email he sent to Gloucester County Deputy Administrator, Jerry White on December 12th requesting the status of the proposed County communications tower, which is to be located in Ward 4. No response was received from that email but Mr. White did request a copy of it on January 28th. The email was faxed to Mr. White on January 28th and still no response has been received. Cncl. Caligiuri noted he is not quite sure where Gloucester County proposes to hide a 200 foot communications tower in Ward 4 and they are not answering his questions.

Cncl. William Sebastian reported attending the February 28th Planning Board Meeting where an application was denied. He also reported the Budget Committee met on Thursday with the BA, CFO and the Auditor to discuss the budget that was introduced this evening. Director of Public Safety, Jim Smart reported after the last council meeting he had a discussion with the County about how to get faster updates on EMS calls and they indicated every time an EMS call comes in they would put it right into the charts and that will help us keep track of our calls.
