What he took from this workshop was that the Mayor is on the right track with trying to market Main Street by organizing members in our community and addressing local ordinances that need to be changed to help make Main Street more He also met with the Director of Business Relations for the marketable to local businesses. Township of Medford, Beth Portocalis who advised him their new mayor and council faced similar issues and changed some of their ordinances and worked with members of the community to make their Main Street thrive. Cncl. Miller noted he will continue discussions with her as she is willing to attend a Main Street Committee Meeting. Under the direction of Mayor Teefy Cncl. Miller noted he would be attending a luncheon meeting with Collingswood Mayor Jim Maley who is a redevelopment attorney and was instrumental in the redevelopment of After the meeting he would make a report to the Mayor, the Main Street Collingswood. Committee and Council. He noted under the Mayor's leadership we are on the right track we just need clear marketing and a clear process for any business that wants to set up shop in Monroe Township. In the future he will also be meeting with Gloucester County Economic Development Director Tom Bianco who walked with us along Main Street to see what we were dealing with. While the goal is to get new business we must not forget about current ones and do everything in our power to keep them in business. He extended his appreciation to the Mayor for his leadership on this and noted he looks forward to seeing Main Street improve and thrive.

Mayor Teefy reported a young lady was hired to fill the part-time clerk position in the Tax Office and on Friday interviews were held and an offer was made for the part-time clerk position in the Community Affairs Office. Job responsibilities of the Community Affairs position and the Parks and Rec position will begin to be combined so those jobs can be shared. The Mayor reported six very good candidates were interviewed for the positions and it was a difficult choice but he felt the right individuals were hired and in the future these employees will be eligible to move into full-time positions. On Wednesday night the Mayor will hold interviews with five candidates for the police officer positions and those selections will be made this week as well

Engineer Dave Cella reported bids for Phase VI of the Winslow Road Project will be opened on April 2^{nd} and the bid will be awarded at the April 13^{th} Council Meeting.

Director of Public Safety, Jim Smart reported The Police Department coordinated with the Public Works Department during the recent snow storm and the snow removal by the Public Works employees was nothing short of stupendous. Many other townships do nothing until the roads are bad but Monroe Township stands out in the work they do. Mayor Teefy agreed they were already moving by the time he and the Deputy Mayor got there. He felt a big thing is communicating with the residents. It was placed on the Township Facebook page as well as the Police Department's and people were able to know where to call, what to do and how to react and they expressed their thanks that we didn't let it go until Monday. Director Smart spoke of how the Police Department jumped in and was pro-active with traffic control so the Road Department could patch potholes. He added he hoped Roads Supervisor Mike Calvello got some rest because he has really been working hard. Mayor Teefy agreed, adding Mike takes a lot of pride in this town. Business Administrator, Kevin Heydel noted people have actually been

stealing the road cones identifying the potholes the Public Works Department has marked for repair.
