E-WASTE DISPOSAL

Due to ongoing changes pertaining to NJDEP E-Waste disposal regulations, are effective

OCTOBER 1, 2011, Monroe Township Department of Public Works will no longer collect TV's curbside.

In addition to all computers and monitors, all *intact* TV's *must be dropped off* at



Public Works located at 1040 Glassboro Road, Williamstown during the hours:

Mon.-Fri. between 7am- 3pm.

Scrap parts from dismantled TV's and computers, including, but not limited to TV/monitor tubes, plastic casings, crushed glass, etc.,

ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE MUNICIPAL E-WASTE RECYCLING PROGRAM. Public Works is not permitted by the NJDEP regulations to accept this type of material.

If tubes from TV's or monitors are brought to the MTDPW by a "scrapper" without the covering and all their parts, they will be rejected.

"BAGSTER" containers.

These waste containers can be independently purchased at various home improvement stores such as Home Depot and Lowe's by a homeowner.

We have found areas where residents have purchased and filled the "BAGSTER" with debris and the container remains roadside for an extended period of time. If a homeowner chooses to use this service in lieu of a private dumpster service it is the homeowner's responsibility to make arrangements through Waste Management for removal of the "BAGSTER."

The Monroe Township Public Works Department, located at 1040 Glassboro Road, will be open to residents for the disposal *BRUSH ONLY (storm debris)*.

No Trash/Bulk Items Will Be Accepted For <u>Disposal!!</u>



Beginning Monday, 8/3, all limbs, branches and small trees/bushes/shrubs shall be no longer than four feet, tied in bundles not to exceed 40 pounds in weight and placed neatly at the curb line for collection.

There shall be no collection of limbs or branches larger than 3 inches in diameter, logs, tree trunks or stumps as per Chapter 239 on the Monroe Township Code.

All bundled brush must be scheduled for bulk pickup with the Public Works Department on your scheduled collection day.

Loose brush and branches may be dropped off at the Public Works Department

Monday – Friday between 7 a.m. – 2 p.m. or Saturday's through the end of September from 8 a.m. to Noon.
