Everyone agreed to change the meeting dates to the 3rd Monday of the month. The new schedule reads as such:


February 22nd, March 21st, April 18th, May 16th, June 20th, July 18th, August no meeting, September 19th, October 17th, November 21st, December no meeting.


Michele said that we should meeting in July instead of December because of how big National Night Out has gotten. Michele made the motion to close the meeting Sue 2nd, all in favor.
