

**MINUTES
SENIORS COMMISSION
TOWNSHIP OF MONROE
MAY 3, 2017**

The Regular Meeting of the Monroe Township Seniors Commission was called to order by Chairperson Jeanette Remsen at 7:03pm in the 2nd Floor Joe Pace Meeting Room of the Municipal Complex. Notice of this meeting was given as required by the annual notice of meetings.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Corine Stark made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted of the Seniors Commission Meeting of March 2, 2017. The motion was seconded by Marita Dinnini and approved by all members of the Commission in attendance; abstain by Virginia Kramer, who was not a member in the March meeting.

CORRESPONDENCE, REPORTS AND OTHER MATTERS

Chairperson Jeanette Remsen welcomed the newest member of the Monroe Township Seniors Commission, Virginia Kramer.

Jeanette noted that Secretary Aileen provided a memo to the Commission requesting approval to dispose of meeting audio recordings (digital files) dating 2013, 2014 and 2015 for the Monroe Township Seniors Commission. Jeanette asked for a motion to approve the disposal of the audio recordings. Jeanette Remsen made a motion, Corine Stark seconded, all in favor; Aileen will process a Request and Authorization for Records Disposal form with NJDORES to dispose of audio dating from 2013 to 2015.

The Commission spoke in reference to the upcoming 2017 trips. Virginia asked Jeanette where their trip fliers are advertised. Jeanette told her that they are put up at the Holiday City Club House, Friendly Village Club House and Pfeiffer Community Center. The info is also posted on Comcast Channel 9 and the township website. June's trip is to see 'My Mother's Italian, My Father's Jewish, I'm STILL in Therapy!' at Caesars Casino on June 28th. July's trip is an 11-mile train ride at Middletown & Hummelstown Railroad, lunch at Alfred's Victorian Restaurant and a 45-minute boat ride on The Pride of the Susquehanna on July 12th, costing only \$58.00. August's trip is to see 'Guys and Dolls' at Bucks County Playhouse, and eating and shopping at Peddler's Village on August 9th. September's trip is to see Frankie Avalon at Caesar's Casino on September 26th. October's trip is to see Patsy Cline at Pines Dinner

Theater on October 18th. November's trip is to see '2017 Christmas Show' at American Music Theater on November 14th. December's trip is to see 'Miracle of Christmas' at Sight & Sound Theatres on December 8th. Jeanette told the members that she received a postcard from Surfflight Theatre, which is located in Beach Haven, NJ. It's been years since the Commission has seen a show there, due to the closing from a fire they had. The postcard was for 2017 shows. For 2018, Jeanette would like for the Commission to look into their shows.

Jeanette said she received a phone call about the Monroe Township Seniors Commission hosting another Red Cross Blood Drive for August 21st. She would like for the Commission to host again, even if they don't make their goal in donations. She will also need help from the members to make phone calls to set appointments.

Jeanette asked the members if they had any suggestions on what to do with the senior citizens in 2018. Suggestions made were an overnight trip in Washington DC with a boat ride on the Potomac River and Big Bus sightseeing tour, a Phillies game, a Broadway show in New York. The members discussed how they could book a Broadway show trip. Jeanette said that they've never booked one, but if they could get all the info together on booking one, maybe they could give it a try.
