The members present discussed this and if they were interested in moving something forward like this in Monroe Township and they all agreed that they would not, and that they would not look to pass any ordinance like this and cause the Village Pet Shop in the Amish market to close.

Vicki then went over a correspondence from Mark Tourscher from Gloucester County that said a resident at 498 Coles Mill Road (Ann Grabowski) had retrieved seven cats from Animal Control and already had 11, not including an already 11 on the property but possibly more. There was a discussion about the situation, and the members discussed the situation and said that they would refer this to the Zoning Office in the case that this may become a shelter and she would need approvals for that.
