Ann Grabowski of 498 Coles Mill Road requested a variance for her cats, and Mark Torchner of the Gloucester County Animal Control was present. Ms. Grabowski said that she has a 30 x 40 barn with four box stalls. The variance is for 18 cats, 3 house cats and 15 outside. People for Animals in Clayton will do the spaying of those that need it when they are trapped, and BCAA will take any litter of kittens once they are born and old enough. The outside cats will be rehomed as quickly as possible. Mark from Gloucester County Animal Control and Ann have been working together and he praised her for what she is doing, and how many she has already helped. The Board members discussed their thoughts about the variance including concerns about additional cats, while others commended Ms. Garbowski for her actions and working with the County. Ms. Grabowski commended the Gloucester County Animal Shelter for all they have done to help and assist her in trapping and rehoming these cats after they are spayed. Mark Torchner thanked her for the kind words.

After the discussion, Jen made a motion to approve the Variance with the condition that there will be only 18 cats, follow Animal Control Guidelines, and notify the Board of Health of reduction in numbers approximately four times a year. The members also agreed to waive the variance fee and the registration of each animal since she was not planning on keeping the cats. Dave second the motion.
