CALL TO ORDER

CORRESPONDENCE, REPORTS AND OTHER MATTERS

Chairperson Jeanette Remsen provided the members with bus/trip prices to review for 2019 trips. She suggested taking a trip to Tomasello Winery for lunch in January 2019. She also suggested taking a trip to Careme's Restaurant at the Academy of Culinary Arts for dinner in February 2019. Jeanette said the Commission is booked for the first (3) months of 2019. She asked the members if they think they need to call people to remind them of the September trip. The members said they have it in their own calendars. Ginny Kramer said she does not mind making the calls to remind everyone. Corrine Stark said she has never received a reminder phone call from a trip from anywhere she has taken a trip with. The members did not agree nor disagree on making reminder phone calls. Jeanette said they are going to the Resorts Casino after the Tomasello Winery in January. She expressed her frustration she had recently received from a resident and a Commission trip on a matter that had arisen. She noted the trip flier for Tomasello will be posted in November. Corrine provided trip information for Dutch Apple and mentioned the Righteous Brothers.

Jeanette said the Blood Drive will be November 26, 2018. She said the Commission will be hosting (3) blood drives a year. She mentioned she made her goal by one pint of blood. Jeanette told the members that each one of them are going to have to run a blood drive. She explained that they will have to run it like she runs it, which is to make the appointment phone calls, because she is not doing it anymore. She will give everyone the names and phone numbers, and she will mail the cards for those who do not want to receive phone calls. Jeanette said the blood drives will probably be scheduled for February, August and November in 2019.

Jeanette said she wants the Secretary, Aileen, to write a letter to Council asking if they will let her have the money that is remaining in the 2018 bus account to use in 2019 toward the 'Jesus' trip. She said there is money leftover because the trip taken in March was her trip that was given to her, money from the Township budget was not used, and only the bus had to be paid for.

Jeanette said she will be attending conventions on October 18, 2018 and October 21, 2018 and will return with information for trips to provide to the members.

Due to technical difficulties, the rest of the Seniors Commission Meeting of September 6, 2018 was not recorded, and the Secretary could not prepare the minutes for the remainder of the meeting.
