

**MINUTES
SENIORS COMMISSION
TOWNSHIP OF MONROE
DECEMBER 6, 2018**

CALL TO ORDER

The Regular Meeting of the Monroe Township Seniors Commission was called to order by Chairperson Jeanette Remsen at approximately 7:00pm in the 2nd Floor Meeting Room of the Municipal Complex. Adequate notice of this meeting was given as required by the annual notice of meetings.

SALUTE TO THE FLAG

Chairperson Jeanette Remsen led the Commission in the salute to our flag.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Marita Dinnini made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted of the Seniors Commission Meeting of November 1, 2018. The motion was seconded by Ginny Kramer and approved by all members of the Commission in attendance, except Corine Stark who Abstained.

CORRESPONDENCE, REPORTS AND OTHER MATTERS

The Seniors Commission Reorganization Meeting will be Thursday, January 10, 2019.

Chairperson Jeanette Remsen said there will be changes made in 2019. She said the trip fliers will go out with “the departure location will be announced at a later time”; the location will not be on the fliers. She said it was suggested that trips must be paid by a certain date, however, it will not be on the flier. Jeanette said, if there is a pay by date, people will wait until the day before to pay; they will not come in to pay her when they see the flier, they will instead wait. Ginny Kramer mentioned having assigned seats in order of how they pay, such as first to pay, first on the bus. Jeanette said that cannot be done because of reasons such as handicap passengers. She will not assign seats. She said some people may not be able to come in to pay right away. She said if the members want to have it that way, she will think about it, otherwise, she does not want to assign seats. Rachel Jezior asked if the fliers can be put out by a certain day, such as the 2nd Friday of each month. Jeanette said that cannot be done because it cannot be guaranteed when she will receive all the trip information from the bus company.

Jeanette discussed the future Commission trips. The January trip is booked and closed. The fliers for the February trip will go out the next day. Corine Stark asked if people can drive in their own vehicles to Careme’s Restaurant instead of taking the bus. Jeanette will have people indicate on their check whether they are taking the bus or driving themselves. She said she has had 65 people attend this trip, however, 42 people can ride the bus. Marita asked Jeanette if she can give the Culinary Arts/Careme’s Restaurant trip

flier to Holiday City for the Holiday Sun paper. The March trip is to Sight & Sound Theaters to see 'Jesus'. The April trip is booked to see 'Mamma Mia' for April 11, 2019. The May trip is booked for Tomasello Winery for May 23, 2019. Jeanette said the Commission cannot book the Crab Trap for June, because they do not accept booking from May to October. The Commission is tentatively booked for October. The members of the Commission discussed the trip to Sight and Sound Theaters. Corine made a motion that the overflow people who were not on the last 'Jesus' trip get first preference. She clarified, Jeannette will call them, give them the date, ask if they are going to take the trip, and when the fliers go out and if there are available seats, they go to anybody else who is interested in going on the trip. The motion was seconded by Ginny Kramer; all in favor. They will be eating at Hershey Farms.

Ginny asked Jeanette how the Blood Drive was. Jeanette said five people could not donate blood, most because of low iron. She said fifteen pints of blood were donated. February 26, 2019 is the next Blood Drive.

Jeanette wished everyone a happy holiday.

With no further business to discuss, Chairperson Jeanette Remsen asked for a motion to adjourn. Corine Stark made a motion to adjourn the Monroe Township Seniors Commission Meeting of December 6, 2018. The motion was seconded by Marita Dinnini; all in favor. Meeting adjourned at 8:00pm.
