APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

RENE PANDOLA made a motion to approve the minutes from the March 14th, 2018 meeting of the Monroe Township Board of Health with the minor revisions made. The motion was seconded by **WILL MCCOOL**

BARBARA CHAMBERLAIN: The total cash settlement for March of 2018 was \$2,763.00.

REPORTS:

VICKI MACHULSKY: Vicki reported that the Township is hosting a Free Public Shredding event at the Monroe Township Public Library on April 22nd and there was a brief discussion in reference to the event.

VICKI MACHULSKY: Vicki reported that we gave Cindy Charney a variance for 934 South Main Street for her four (4) dogs. Animal Control called Vicki to see if she came in for a variance and Vicki told them she already had one. Vicki reported that she ran into Cindy at Shoprite and was informed that Cindy had moved and is no longer living in town. Vicki reported that Cindy apparently moved her dogs in with her daughter on Madison Avenue and Animal Control had pictures stating that there was four (4) dogs and Vicki stated that her dogs are not licensed. Vicki stated that Cindy came in and licensed three (3) of the dogs and notified her that her one (1) dog named flower was no longer with her because she had been adopted out. Vicki said that even though she had told her that she only had three (3) dogs, Animal Control insisted there was four (4) dogs so Vicki wrote her a violation letter. Vicki stated that Cindy was also given a ticket from Animal Control and her court hearing is on May 1st. Vicki informed her in a letter that the South Main Street variance does not move with the dogs to the Madison Avenue address. There was a discussion in reference to the original reason that Cindy ended up with the dogs from her daughter in the first place.

VICKI MACHULSKY: Vicki reported that the Mayor went to the TNBR program People for Animals and the Mayor said it seemed very interesting. The Mayor stopped into see Vicki in reference to it and Vicki notified him that our Board did discuss and Vicki informed him that we would discuss it further. There was a discussion in reference to the program, how it's funded, how it works and the other Townships who have adopted the program. There was also a discussion about the decline in the number of cats being euthanized since the adoption of the program.

DAN KOZAK: Nothing to report.

WILL MCCOOL: Nothing to report.

JENNIFER TOAL: Commented on corner of Winslow Road and Malaga Road in reference to the tires and the couch. **DAN KOZAK** reported that the tires and couch were gone. There was a discussion in reference to that home and the owner of the property. Jen also asked if the Township sprayed for ticks. There was a discussion in reference to spraying certain areas for ticks and tick issues in general.
