

1. I was not able to find the RFP on the Township's website as indicated in the RFP. Can you confirm that all addenda will be posted to the Township's website and if so, can you provide a link to the correct webpage?

2. Are there any requirements like snow guards or water management for the solar canopy systems that we should adhere to in designing the system?

Snow guards and water management are highly recommended, but we have not specified this in the RFPS.

3. Are there restrictions regarding times of day that work can take place at the sites? Can you provide any and all schedule restrictions we should be aware of?

Since we are still assessing what may happen in the fall, we won't know until things clear up with the Corona Virus.

4. In the RFP-Qualified-Solar-Provider-Questions-5.pdf document, the answer to question #5 states that bidders should use 400,000 kWh as the "not to exceed" kWh for the Library. However, page 12 of the RFP states that the "not to exceed" output amount should be 450,000 kWh. Can you confirm which of these numbers we should target?

The reduced number is due to having future energy efficiency projects completed.

5. In addition to the base bid containing systems on all the sites listed in the RFP as a package, will you accept bids for individual sites as well? For instance, if one project is not economically feasible and its inclusion would reduce the economic benefit to the Township/BOE, it might be beneficial for the Township to pick and choose among projects.

We are only entertaining one bid for all of the locations together.
