

**MINUTES

Jim talked about possibly using the Township buses a few times during the month of December to take the seniors around town to look at the Christmas lights. Cncl. Falcone confirmed with Brandee Derieux at Community Affairs that the Commission could use the Township buses to take the seniors around town and judge the Christmas lights in December. A discussion followed regarding scheduling a few nights in December to tour the Township, looking and judging the Christmas lights.

Jim spoke regarding the current vacant positions on the Commission.
