The resident who owns the cats has a Go Fund Me page in place to raise the funds necessary to properly care for the cats as she does not have the funding on hand to pay for all the things they need but she wishes to keep the cats. Animal control was sent out and reported their findings to Vicki. Vicki then sent notice to the resident that she needed to apply for a variance with the Board of Health in order for her to keep them as the Township has an Ordinance in place that states you are only allowed to have 3 cats and 3 dogs. There was a discussion in reference to this matter.

CHARLOTTE RUDOLPH: Stated that Vicki forwarded an email from a resident to the members of the Board of Health that was sent to the Mayor and all Town Council members in reference to why The TNR (Trap Neuter and Release Program) is not in the best interest of the Township and/or the Animals.
