Mayor Wolfe addressed Mr. Mellace's concerns, noting he will look into how the Ordinance can be amended to help the small businesses and in reference to the community playgrounds, that is something that can be looked at in the future. Cncl. Adams noted, the Economic Development Commission has discussed with the Mayor creating Business Directories to be distributed to the current and new residents, which will help to promote the in-town small businesses.

Sherrie Kennedy, 375 Bryn Mawr Drive, spoke regarding Ordinance O:10-2024, questioning if all of the residents located on the listed streets were notified, to which Mayor Wolfe explained the reason for the addition of Ketal Avenue to the Ordinance. Ms. Kennedy questioned the enforcement of all of the roads listed within the Ordinance. Ms. Kennedy spoke
