D.) MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION

• Chapter 230 Peddlers & Solicitors

Mayor Wolfe spoke regarding Chapter 230 "Peddlers & Solicitors", explaining by amending the Code, it will provide Council the opportunity to help the town's small businesses and also ensure the safety of the residents. He believes there is a happy medium where the Township can help the local businesses by allowing those businesses to email the Police Department, the Police Chief or his designee, a list of names of the individuals and their information who will be passing out the flyers the day of "solicitation" and the areas that will be visited instead of having to follow the current somewhat lengthy process stated within the Code. He would like to see language added to the Code to reflect the following: there is to be no physical or verbal communication with any resident, just the simple placement of the literature on the door, the business will have to pull the No-Knock Registry to ensure the literature does not get distributed to anyone on that list, the businesses must provide the names of the individuals who will be distributing literature to the Police Department, and lastly the business owner is responsible for ensuring that the individuals distributing are of good character and do Solicitor Graise expressed her concerns with the proposed not have criminal records. amendments and language to Chapter 230 "Peddlers & Solicitors". A discussion followed regarding the proposed amendments to Chapter 230 "Peddlers & Solicitors".

• <u>Permitting Banners</u>

Mayor Wolfe spoke in reference to the current Ordinance pertaining to permitting banners, explaining it currently only allows a business to have one (1) sign at their business with an additional sign allowed once per year for thirty (30) days in a ninety (90) day period. He suggested, extending the allowance of the additional sign for once per year for a maximum of ninety (90) days instead of thirty (30) days. A discussion followed regarding extending the times allowed for additional signs. **Cncl. Adams** suggested allowing additional signs twice a year for a maximum of ninety (90) days total to which all members of Council in attendance agreed.

E.) <u>NEW BUSINESS</u>

Solicitor Graise explained that as part of the municipal land sale held in December 2023, one of the properties, due to a tax assessment error was input on a different road and the individuals who purchased the property were under the impression that it was on one road when it is in fact on another road. She noted, deeds have been prepared and picked up, however, the buyers wish to reverse the sale, which will require an Ordinance. Solicitor Graise asked the members of Council in attendance for permission to prepare an Ordinance to reverse the sale to be presented at the next scheduled Council Meeting for approval, to which Cncl. O'Reilly asked for more information. A discussion ensued regarding the land sale purchase.

G.) **PUBLIC PORTION**

Cncl. Pres. Valcourt made a motion to open the Public Portion. The motion was seconded by **Cncl. Fox** and unanimously approved by all members of Council in attendance.

Sherrie Kennedy, 375 Bryn Mawr Drive addressed Council to express her concerns with the proposed amendments to Chapter 230 Peddlers & Solicitors. Mayor Wolfe addressed her concerns.

With no one else wishing to speak, Cncl. Fox made a motion to close the Public Portion. The motion was seconded by Cncl. O'Reilly and unanimously approved by all members of Council in attendance.

H.) ADJOURNMENT

With nothing further to discuss, Cncl. Fox made a motion to adjourn the Ordinance Committee Meeting of May 8, 2024. The motion was seconded by Cncl. Pres. Valcourt and unanimously approved by all members of Council in attendance.
